Celebrating 2016 Achievements

2016 was an exciting year of growth and innovation for the International Antimicrobial Council (IAC). Together, with our members and partners, we were able to expand the number of IAC Certified Laboratories in the United States, Spain, Central America, and China while providing essential education to retailers and brand name companies.

- The IAC partnered for the first time with the IFAI (Industrial Fabrics Association International) to provide educational programs to their members while growing the IAC membership and increasing the number of major brand name companies actively involved in the IAC.
- We increased our public exposure by adding a Mobile Training Center that travels the highways of America. The MTC will be featured at conferences and brand offices again this summer.
- The IAC blazed a new frontier by launching the IAC Test Verification Program that systemizes and verifies the use of proper test procedures helping microbiological laboratories provide accurate, reproducible test results that are comparable with other laboratories performing the same test methods on the same antimicrobial treated substrates.
- Through our Saginaw Valley State University microbiological laboratory, the IAC has been serving IAC members with a limited amount of microbiological testing while continuing the essential market and technical training that our members have come to expect from the IAC.

Our partnership with SVSU has been very beneficial to both entities. Students experience microbiology in practical commercial applications and are able to contribute to the development of new and improved industry procedures, methods, and standards.
